





The official ECC hotel was build and opened in 2007 and features 142 luxury nonsmoking rooms and 14 multifunctional conference rooms.

3. The Hague area

"Oh, Oh, The Hague beautiful town behind the dunes, the 'Zuiderpark', 'de Lange Poten' and the 'Plein'... Oh, oh, The Hague"

These are the beginning lyrics of a song sung in coarse 'Hague' language about what was and what is. A real folk town with it's own footballteam ADO. A city with quirky residential areas where, next to 'Hagenaars', many other cultures have found its place.

We will show you around with tramline 9 that is waiting for you at about 150 metres from our bowlingcentre and we will first subside to the 'Binnenhof' where the Dutch Parliament resides with the top attraction the 'Ridderzaal' (Knight's Hall).



From here we will carry on and after a short 10 to 15 minute walk we will reach the workpalace of Queen Beatrix which is part of the city centre where you can also do some excellent shopping.

The highlight of the Binnenhof undoubtebly was and is the Ridderzaal, which was built by



count Floris V in the 13th century.

From the workpalace of the queen it is possible to proceed to the 'Vredespaleis' (Peace palace) or go

back to tramline 9 to continue our journey in the direction of 'Madurodam' When making a short visit to the Hague, it is possible to see the Netherlands in miniature in a few hours. Obviously all is recreated in scale but it will give the visitor a good impression of matters that take place in the Netherlands.

The palace is the result of an international contest of which the winning design was made by the French architect Cordonnier.

The Permanent Court of Arbitration, the International Court of Justice, the Academy of Internation Law and a lovely library are located at the 'Vredespaleis' The 'Engelse Droppot' (English licorice jar) can be found in Madurodam as well as the centre of The Hague during shopping.



After seeing the Netherlands in miniature it is time to go on in the direction of the beach. Time to feel the breeze in your hair, have a bite of fish or have a gamble in the casino. A visit to the 'Kurhaus' is also definitely worthwhile.

When all breezed out we will again hop on tramline 9 to arrive at Zuiderpark after a small city tour which will take about half an hour.

4. Zalm Bowlingcentre Zuiderpark Den Haag



This 16 lane center is best known to most European bowlers as BowlingWorld Zuiderpark and host of the "BBWZ B-klassen Tournament" and the YET BBWZ Youth Tournament since 2002. The bowling has Brunswick GSX machines, (with) Pro Anvilane Synthetic lanes and approaches, in combination with Qubica Conquest computerscore. For the ECC 2012 Zalm Bowlingcentre Zuiderpark will use a tournament set of Twister pins.

The center itself is on the first floor, entered by two stairs or elevator and has a total space of approximately 1600 square meters recreational area. This includes a small restaurant that is located within the bowling center where you can enjoy good food at reasonable prices. The center will sell bottled sodas. All public areas in the Netherlands are submitted to a ban on smoking, so smoking will not be allowed inside the bowling center. Outside there is a free public parking area to accommodated 400 cars. We do however strongly recommend you to use the tournament shuttles and/or public transport.

6. Facilities / Services

Website:

The official website of the ECC 2012 is www.ecc2012.eu and it will continuously be updated with all information concerning the Championships.

Press Room:

One meeting room at bowling centre will be reserved as a working media room, providing high-speed access to printers and to the internet, free of charge for all accredited press officials. Please understand that players, coaches and team managers are not allowed to use the press facilities unless they are working to provide updates to press in their home countries and have been accredited beforehand.

Results:

Teams, federations and press will be provided with scores after each game as well as with complete standings after each squad. Standings will be presented at various locations in the centre both in the spectators' area and in the players' area. In addition, all results will be published on the official website www.ecc2012.eu.

Shuttles (Airport, Accommodation, Bowling Centre):

All delegations will be met at Schiphol International Airport upon arrival and will be transported to the official bowlers accommodation. A similar delivery service will be provided for departures. Federations must provide their flight arrival and departure times with Form C to make this service work properly.

A shuttle bus service between the official Accommodation and bowling center will be provided to all players, coaches, officials and supporters with an official entry.

Please understand that we cannot provide airport transfers or shuttle services for teams arriving before October 14th or leaving after October 22nd.

Equipment storage:

Bowling equipment must be stored in a designated area at the bowling center. Follow the ball-parking signs.

Ball registration:

Prior to the start of the official practise the bowling balls to be used during competition shall be inspected and registered. The inspection shall be limited to:

- Eligibility of the ball as specified in the list of approved bowling balls
- Serial number
- Visual inspection with regard to material, surface, plugs, etc.

Farewell Banquet:

The farewell banquet will be held Sunday October 21^{st} , 2012 from 20.00 o'clock. Location to be announced.

Tickets for the Farewell Banquet will be charged (subject to availability), but the banquet will be complimentary for all players and members of the official delegations with a valid entry.











Unofficial practice:

Lanes will be available for unofficial practice on Monday October 15^{th} from 10.00 - 21.00. Squad times for the unofficial practice being every hour.

Limited number of lanes may be available in some squads due to lane maintenance.

For the unofficial practice, the lanes will be dressed with two lane patterns, but these patterns will not be the official tournament patterns.

Bookings for unofficial practice can be made to: blund@ecc2012.eu or using the official form. All bookings are available on first come, first served basis.

Payment can be made by invoice together with entry fees or on site prior to the practice session.

Practice fee is 30,- EUR for one pair for one hour. Lanes will be dressed at least after two hours of play.

Please check in for your unofficial practice session at least 20 min. prior to your reserved squad time. Unpaid bookings can be given away to other federations if federations do not show up for check-in.











7. Fees

Delegations Entry Fee:

The ECC 2012 entry fee is \leqslant 210, - per person for all players, coaches and officials as members of the official delegation. This fee includes the delegation fee to be paid to ETBF and covers participation, transports and the Farewell Banquet.

Guest:

The fee for supporters is \in 100, - per person. This fee includes transports and the Farewell Banquet.

Press officials:

Unless they have any duties at ECC 2012 related to a team or federation, there will be no entry fee for accredited press officials except for participation in the Farewell Banquet.

Unofficial practice:

Fees for the unofficial practice must be paid together with fees or prior to practice on site in the center as stated in section 6. Facilities / Services.

Accommodation:

Please remember that the accommodation fees have to be paid to the Netherlands Bowling Federation as stated in section 2. Official Accommodation.

Spectators:

There will be no entrance fee for spectators to the ECC 2012.

Payment of Fees:

All fees must be paid in advance. Federations will receive an invoice after having submitted their forms and are kindly requested to transfer the entry and accommodation fees no later than September 15th 2012 *) to the following account:

8. Visa information



Short stay visa for the Netherlands

Entry visas are required for citizens of some countries. The entry forms are not valid as visas!

This is a current list of European countries whose citizens will not need a visa if staying less than 90 days. However, all federations should confirm this information independently:

Albania*), Israel, Croatia, San Marino, Serbia*), and all European Union / Schengen countries

*) Nationals of Albania and Serbia in principle do nor require a visa, unless they still have a non-bio metric passport. In that case, they require a visa, albeit at a lower fee.

Federations for which a visa is required for a maximum stay of 3 months in the Netherlands:

Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Moldavia, Russia, Turkey, The Ukraine, South Africa.

Visa applicants are advised to apply at least 3 months in advance!

Attached to this bulletin are the following forms:

Form A: Entry form The deadline for Form A is June 30th, 2012.

Please return this form even if you do not want to participate in the ECC 2012. Federations sending the Entry Form later than June 30th, 2012 will not be able to participate in the European Champions Cup 2012. No exceptions for any reason can be made for those missing the deadline.

Form B: Accommodation form Deadline for Form B is June 30th, 2012.

Please return this form even if you choose to accommodate your delegation at any other hotel than the official accommodation. All reservations must be made through the Host Tournament Committee using Form B and bookings have to be paid *in advance* to the Host Tournament Committee *as described in section 7*. We cannot provide shuttle services from/to the airport or from/to the bowling center for federations that decide to stay in any other hotel.

Federations sending the Accommodation Form B later than June 30^{th} . 2012 cannot expect to be accommodated in the official accommodation at the special ECC rates. These special rates will not apply to reservations made directly with the accommodation.
